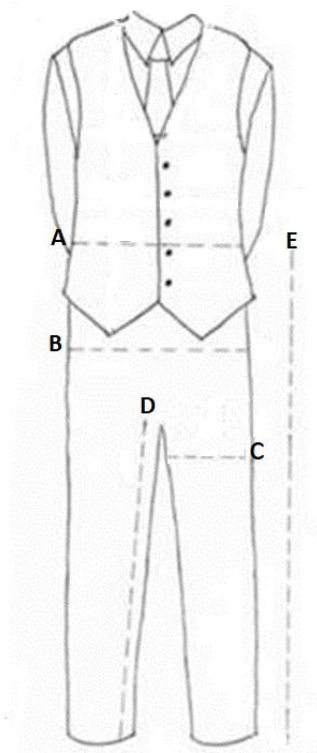


## Measuring Guide for Normal Waist Trews



The following measurements are required in inches only, please stand straight and look forward throughout the measuring process:-

- A Waist:** Measure around the normal trouser waistline.
- B Seat:** Measure around the 'fullest/biggest part' of the 'buttocks/derriere', which sticks out the most.
- C Thigh:** Measure around the widest part of the thigh.
- D Inside Leg:** Measure from where the crotch seam meets the top of the inside leg seam, down to your 'preferred length' of trouser.\*
- E Outside Leg:** Measure from your waist down to your 'preferred length' of trouser.\*

### \* Your 'Preferred Length' of Trouser:

Wear a pair of 'dress' trousers that you already like the 'finished length' of. And measure from the top of the waistband, to that actual '**preferred length**', where the bottom of your trouser falls, to obtain the 'outside leg' measurement. Then measure to the same preferred length from the crotch seam as detailed above, for the 'inside leg' measurement.

A good check for this, is to lay those same dress trousers out flat and measure the outside and inside leg again, in the same way.

**Height:** In 'feet & inches', thank you.

**IMPORTANT:** Please do not self-measure. Have a family member/colleague take each measurement. To ensure accuracy, **DOUBLE CHECK** all your measurements. As we cannot offer refunds on made to measure items. Any ill-fitting garments in need of adjustment are the responsibility of each customer.
