

## Measuring Guide for Normal Waist Trews

- Do not use any other measuring guide to send us your measurements, **use this guide only.**
- The following measurements are required in **inches only.**
- Stand straight and look forward throughout the measuring process.
- Do not self-measure, have a friend or relative do this.
- Use a cloth/plastic tape measure, not a DIY metal one.
- Measurements are to be taken against your **bare skin, not over clothes for: 'waist, seat and thigh'.**
- Do not trust your memory, write each measurement down as it is taken.

**Waist:** Measure around your natural waistline.

**Seat:** Measure around the 'fullest/biggest part' of the 'buttocks', which sticks out the most.

**Thigh:** Measure around the widest part of the thigh.

**Inside Leg:** Measure from where the crotch seam meets the top of the inside leg seam, down the inside of your leg, to your preferred length of trouser.

**Outside Leg:** Measure from your waist, down the side of your leg, to your preferred length of trouser.

**Height:** In 'feet & inches'.

### To check you have your inside and outside leg measurement correct:

- Lay out flat, a pair of dress trousers that you already wear and you like the length of.
- Measure from where the crotch seam meets the top of the inside leg seam, down the inside, to the bottom of the trouser, to get your **'inside leg'** measurement.
- Then measure from the top of the waistband, down the side, to the bottom of the trouser, to obtain the **'outside leg'** measurement.
